“When did the consultations take place? If I can get a legislative return on whom the minister met with or the Yukon Housing Corporation met with. As I said in my letter, former ministers and premiers met on many occasions with seniors in every community in the Yukon. I think you have to meet face-to-face as a minister. You hold the budget strings, and that’s who they want to see. “

The response is as follows:

The development of a new Yukon Housing Corporation strategic plan was a collaborative process with a variety of stakeholders.

During the fall of 2017, we sought input from:

- Yukon Housing Corporation Board of Directors,
- Yukon Housing Corporation staff/management,
- Whitehorse Housing Advisory Board, and
- Community Housing Advisory Boards.

We also engaged the Housing Action Plan Implementation Committee in the development of the strategic plan. This committee includes representatives from:

- Government of Yukon
- First Nation governments,
- municipal governments,
- the private sector, and
- non-profit organizations.

The strategic plan was also informed by a broad range of housing and social statistics as well as recent public and client surveys undertaken by the Yukon Bureau of Statistics.
