The response is as follows:

In the 2017-18 fiscal year, Yukon Housing Corporation had eight active Rental Suite Loans and advanced \$124,500 throughout the fiscal year.

Over the past two years there were two grant programs that focused on rental units, the Rental Quality Enhancement Grant and the Municipal Matching Rental Construction Grant programs both had significant advances. Rental Quality Enhancement Grant had 50 active files in 2017-18 with a total of \$547,500 advanced and the Municipal Matching Rental Construction Grant, which supports the construction of rental suites, had 48 active files for a total of \$662,500 advanced during the fiscal year.
