The response is as follows:

QUESTION: Can the minister tell us what is going to happen in the bus schedule in this coming year and if these people have recourse?

ANSWER: When the department was asked to establish a bus stop at the top of Grizzly Way road at the beginning of the 2016/2017 school year, staff worked with the bus company (Standard Bus) to determine whether the request could be accommodated.

It was determined that a bus stop could not be established at that location due to safety and other considerations. An alternate bus stop has been added at the end of Grizzly Way, where the students can be safely picked up and dropped off.

The family has been provided with a Transportation Subsidy (because they live more than 3.2 km from the bus stop since September 2016).
