The answer is as follows:

- In Transportation Division's 5-year capital plan:
 - Approximately 43 projects will likely require, or have already been assessed, under the *Yukon Environmental and Socio-economic Assessment Act*.
 - Approximately 61 projects will likely not require an assessment under YESAA.
 - For approximately 20 projects, whether they will require an assessment is unknown because project details and activities have yet to be determined.
- For Property Management Division, it remains to be determined whether or not the French Secondary School project requires YESAB approval.
- Final determinations regarding the requirement for assessments are based on the scope of work and triggers under the act. Therefore, the numbers provided above are only an estimate.
