The response is as follows:

The feedback from the survey is one of the factors we will consider in determining the school calendars for the next four years. We will also consider other input we have received from staff and school communities and factors to support student learning.

The school calendar survey closed on October 16, 2017. There have been approximately 1700 responses to the survey. We expect to process, compile and analyze all the responses to this survey and to share more about the findings by mid-November.

At that time, we will provide the public with as much information as possible about the survey so that everyone can see the results, while making sure that we respect respondents' confidentiality and privacy.

The next step will be to develop the school calendars for the next four years, which will be shared with School Councils and staff as soon as possible. Going forward, each year we will work with schools and School Councils to set the next year's school calendar, so that four years of school calendar dates are always available to the public.
