She went on to say – and I quote: “The number of EAs will be adjusted over the summer...” Could the minister update us on what the current number of EAs is this year?

The response is as follows:

In May of the last school year, the department of education allocated a total of 210 FTEs for educational assistants across all Yukon schools for the 2017/18 school year based on the needs of students and projected enrollment numbers.

These allocations are adjusted at the beginning of the school year based on any increased student need and the actual enrolment numbers at the schools.

Based on the needs and enrollment numbers, the current need for EAs is 246.4 FTEs.
