Ms. White: The Government of Yukon employs roughly 5,500 people. How many of those are ticketed tradespeople?

The response is as follows:

- The Trades Group is an occupational group within Yukon government's position classification plan. This group includes skilled positions which generally require completion of a recognized apprenticeship program and receipt of an approved journeyman certificate.
- As of April 29, 2019, there are 110 ticketed tradespeople occupying positions that fall under the Trades Group. 79% of the ticketed tradespeople are in the department of Highways and Public Works.
