**Heritage Hunting and Fishing Act**

WHEREAS hunting and fishing are an important part of Yukon's heritage and form an important part of the fabric of present-day life in Yukon;

AND WHEREAS hunters and anglers contribute to the understanding, conservation, and management of fish and wildlife in Yukon;

AND WHEREAS the best traditions of recreational hunting and fishing are valued and should be maintained for future generations;

AND WHEREAS this legislation recognizes the authority of the Umbrella Final Agreement and the Yukon Fish and Wildlife Management Board;

The Commissioner of Yukon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly, enacts as follows

- 1 A person has the right to hunt and fish in accordance with the law.
